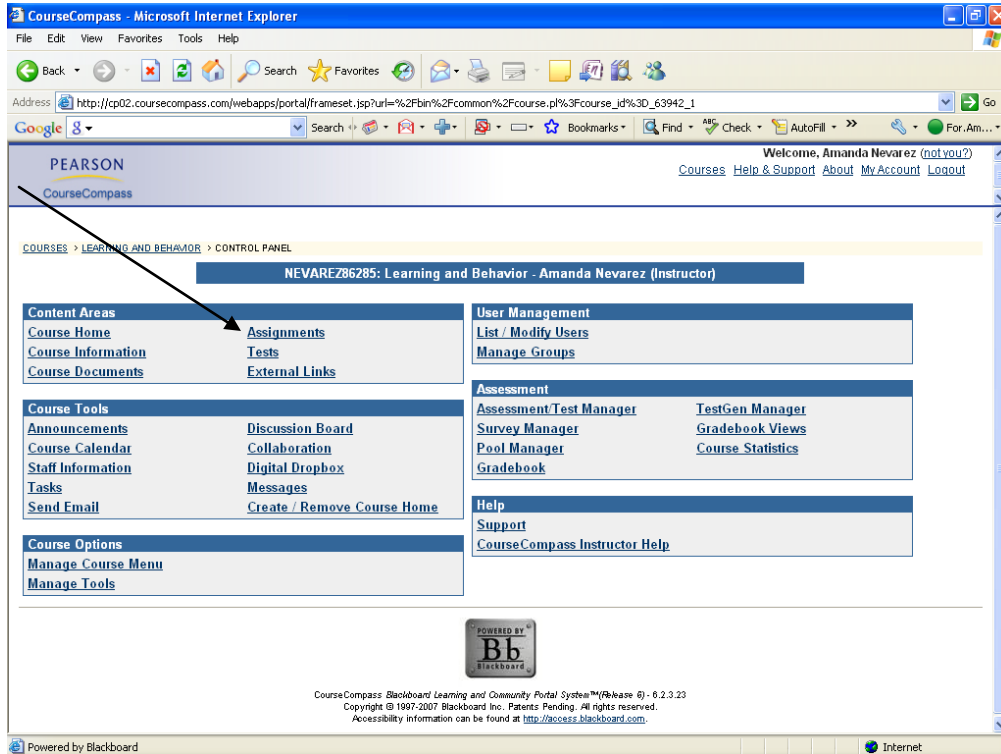
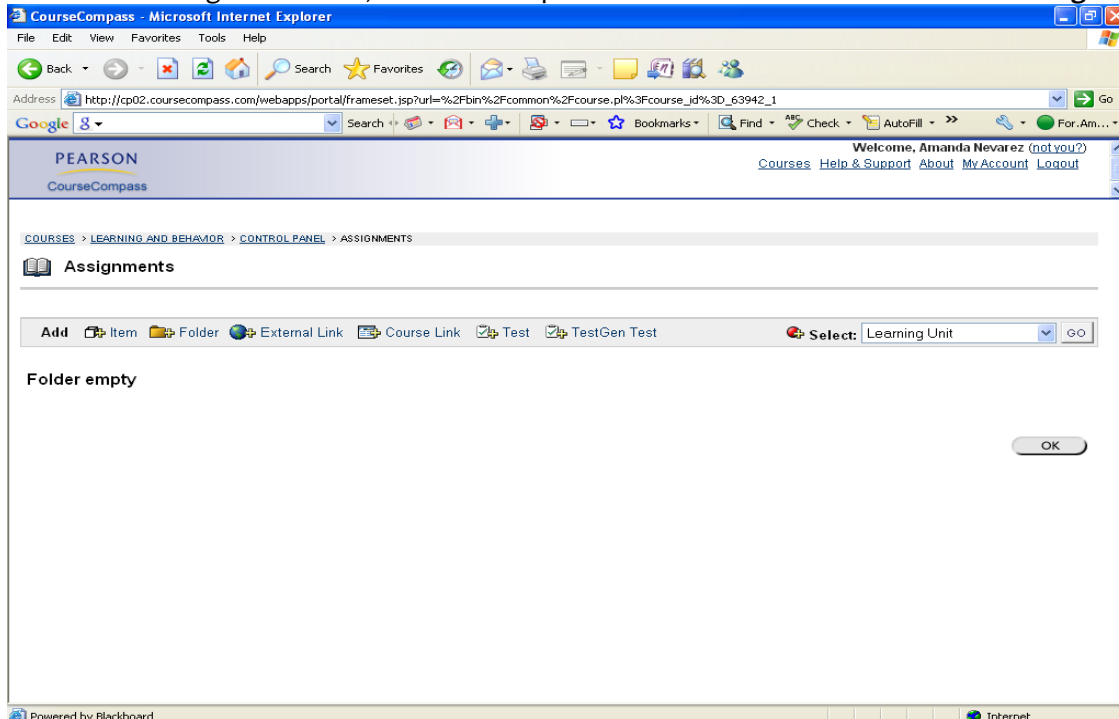


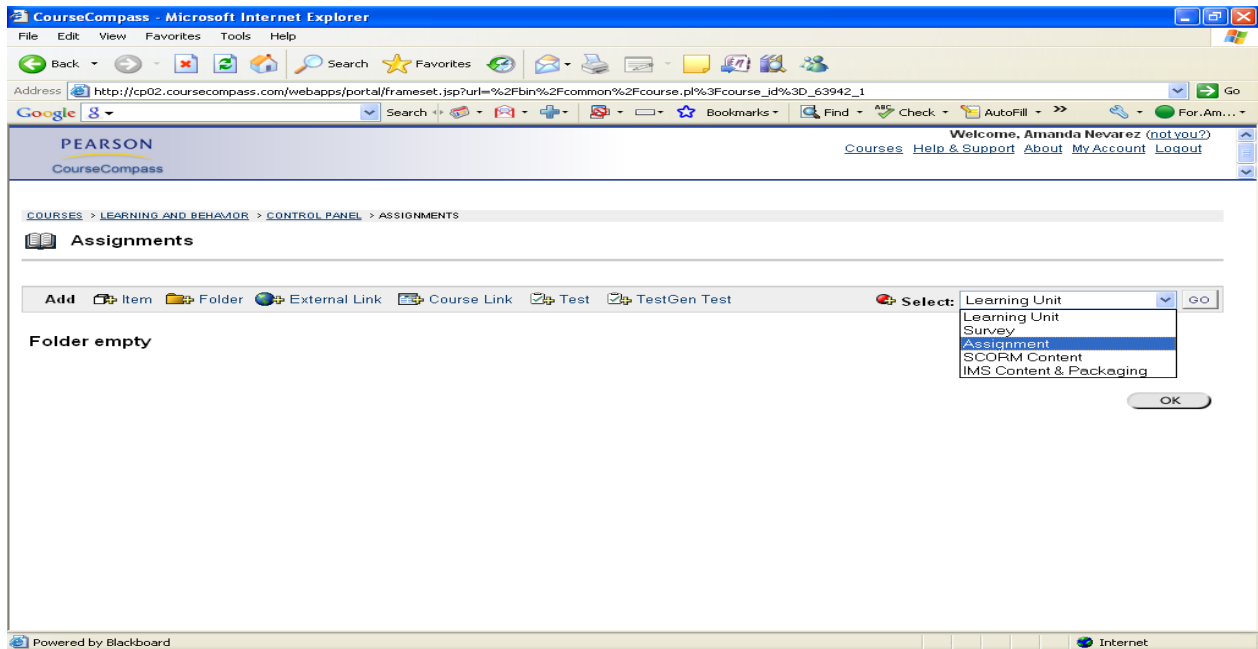
In order to have students submit assignments that can be graded, you will need to add the assignment using the following instructions, once logged into CourseCompass:

- Click **Go**. (The following page will appear.)

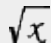

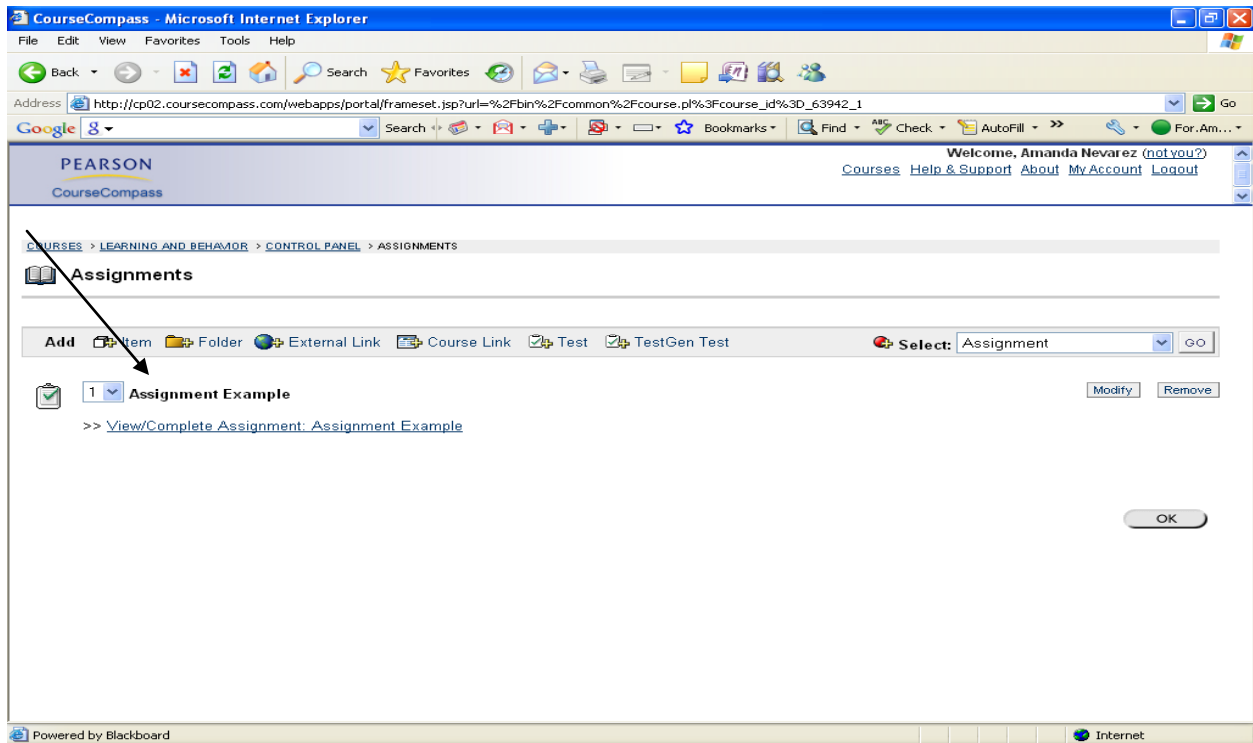
## 4 Submit
